#### **Head Lice**

Please be vigilant in checking your child's hair regularly for head lice. One treatment is not enough if eggs remain in the hair. There must be a follow up treatment no more than 7 days after the first. Checking every 2-3 days is the best way to keep on top of head lice. Use conditioner and run the comb through to make sure there is nothing in the hair.
