Existing students who do not yet know their class for 2019, can continue to utilise their current class until it is updated.

The uniform shop will also be available for fittings at that same time. Purchases made on the day will be cash only – hence any parents / carers who wish to pay via card need to do so via Flexishools before 23 January 2019 in order to collect clothing on 29 January.

In support of the start of a new year and term, we will also be opening the uniform shop on the first day of term Wednesday January 2019 between 8:45 and 9:30am for any last minute uniform needs.

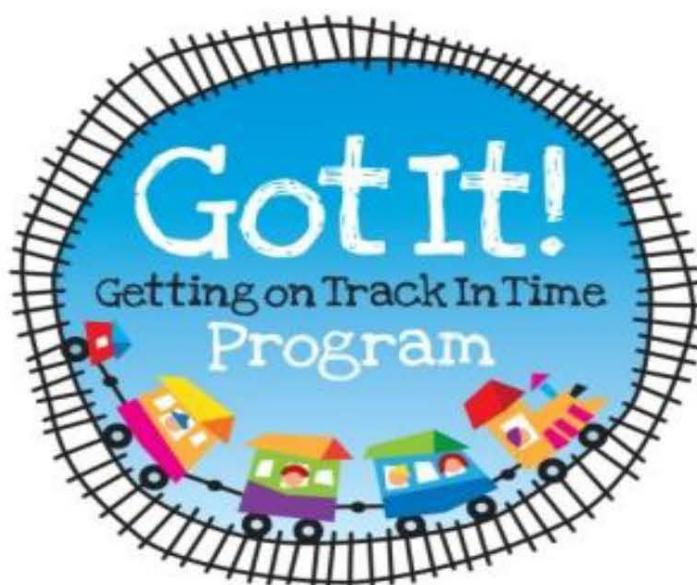
